### **“HANK PARKER, JR., NO. 21 TOYOTA/WHITE HOUSE FOODS KANSAS POST RACE REPORT“**

MOORESVILLE, NC (July 5, 2004) Hank Parker, Jr., driving the Innovative Motorsports No. 21 Toyota, battled an extremely loose handling racetruck to finish 21<sup>st</sup> in the O'Reilly Auto Parts 250.
